

**MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF GREENBUSH
PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE BUDGET AND
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE ELECTORS
NOVEMBER 13, 2025 – 7:00 P.M.**

Public Hearing:

The public hearing was called to order by Chairman Mike Limberg at 7:00 p.m. Board members present were Miles Shaw, Tony Wagner, and Mary Kracht. Steve Dickman (resident) and Jonathan Stormoen (non resident) were also present.

Clerk/Treasurer Jon Miller described changes in the 2026 budget from the previous year. These include the slight property tax increase proposed and the increases in shared revenue and county sales tax. Miller noted tax increases from the school districts and county will affect property owners more significantly. Less interest earning is anticipated because of the final spending of federal funds. The expense budget will largely mirror the 2025 without spending for reassessment which is completed. A set aside of \$8000 was included to purchase land for the Center Street Bridge repair. The need to fund checks and four elections was also mentioned. Steve Dickman outlined maintenance projects that may be necessary for 2026 including painting of window flashings, ballards, and installation of fan covers.

Motion Dickman/Limberg to adjourn public hearing at 7:13 p.m. Motion carried.

Special Town Meeting of the Electors:

Chairman Limberg called the Special Town Meeting of the Electors to order at 7:14 p.m.

Motion by Dickman/Limberg to set the 2025 Town of Greenbush tax levy (which is paid in 2026) at \$104,614 to be paid pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Special Town Meeting of the Electors, motion Dickman/Limberg to adjourn at 7:17 p.m. Motion carried.
